## **Instructions: Masonic Symbol**

## Additional Instructions:

- 1. Any piece smaller than 1" in diameter should be re-sawn or sanded from a thicker wood (the pieces for the letter G) plates 2 3 and 4.
- 2. Follow the general directions with the exception of plate #1 (which is a "flip plate")
- 3. Start by removing the collar from your inlay kit. Cut pieces for each pocket keeping in mind you must flip plate 1 horizontally and cut another piece for each pocket.
- 4. Use the engraving on one of the plates to set the position of the finished inlay on your project. Then tape down positioning plates with double sided tape.

- 5. Cutting pockets for plate #1 must be completed in three steps. One, using plate #1 cut a pocket for pocket marked A on plate. Glue in then let dry and sand flush. Two, Flip plate horizontally and cut pockets marked B on plate. Glue in then let dry and sand flush. Three, Flip plate over and cut pocket marked C on plate. Glue in then let dry and sand flush.
- 6. Complete plates 2 3 and 4 between each plate, let dry sand flush in numerical order.
