Additional Instructions: YIN YANG

However this particular design does require some additional instructions besides the basics available in the above mentioned video...

- 1. Some parts for this inlay need to be cut in thicker material and re-sawn out, because of their small size. (Small circles on plate#3)
- 2. For clarity, directions are to recreate with the same woods as the display. However you can use any type of wood that you like. The thing that makes every inlay special is finding the perfect color or wood grain to accentuate the design.

Step 1 Cut your inlay pieces. Be sure that the collar is removed from your 1/8 In. inlay kit.

Cut plate #1 from Quarter sawn Sycamore 1/4 In. thick. Be sure not to bottom out the bit into the inlay kit.

Note: Be sure to mark orientation of this piece with an arrow pointing to the top this will make a better fit when inserting the inlay.

Cut plate#2 from Wenge' 1/8 In. thick

Cut plate#3 top hole Wenge' 1/8 In. thick. Bottom hole Quarter sawn Sycamore.

Step#2 Set up positioning plates on your project piece. Be sure collar is installed on the inlay kit. Using plate #1 rout out the pocket. Remove plate and glue inlay in place, let dry then sand flush.

Step#3 Follow directions in step#2 for remaining plates in numerical order.
